

## OHIO TECH PREP ACADEMY

### University of Cincinnati Credit Option

Participants in the *Ohio Tech Prep Academy* are eligible to register for graduate or undergraduate credit from the University of Cincinnati. This credit option is made available through the Economics Center for Education & Research in cooperation with Ohio Tech Prep.

**Credit** **One (1) to Three (3) quarter hours graduate or undergraduate credit.**  
One (1) quarter hour of graduate credit for each 10 clock hours of work. A total of 3 quarter hours for the academy sessions plus the on-line follow-up work.

**UC Course** **15-ECON-538, Study of American Industry (Tech Prep)**  
Registration is for the 3<sup>rd</sup> summer session. Grades will be reported October 20, 2009.

**Credit Payment** **\$199 payment per credit hour.** (Full UC tuition is normally \$425 per credit hour)  
1 - 3 quarter hours, graduate or undergraduate credit. The Economics Center will provide a scholarship for the remaining UC tuition cost.

**Registration** Complete the UC "Omni" registration form. Submit both copies of the form. Your payment by check should accompany the reg. form. Checks should be payable to University of Cincinnati. For credit card payment, call Doug Haskell at 513-556-2951 for information about how to pay online.

**Requirements** Credit is available for one (1) to three (3) quarter hours. Participants are eligible for one credit hour for each ten hours of instructional time. Participant time will be documented by the program staff. Participants must meet all requirements of the workshop as designed by the Tech Prep staff and instructors, including session participation and follow-up work.
